



The Southeast Region (an area on Earth with common features that set it apart from other areas)





Our international studies includes touring through Canada and Scandinavia. Through research and lessons we learn about the geography, climate, culture, and many other interesting facts about these regions.




Nunavut

An *inuksuk* is a stone monument which is used to guide people and mark special or sacred places.


The single star represents the north star - known as *Nigirtsuitug* in the native tongue.

Adopted on April 1, 1999 when the territory of Nunavut was formed.


